Jamia Urdu Hind is an un-aided State's Madarsa-Tul-Oloom designed and established for research in Urdu language and literature of national importance since British imperialism to educate those who are not educated through mainstream schooling and is established in such a locality of Raigarh, Solapur, Murshidabad, Mehzurnagar, Azimabad, Viratnagaretc which has the highest number of rickshaw-puller and public below poverty line (BPL) in the country where the condition of the people is worse than SC/ST because average life-span is ~52 years and infant mortality is highest in the world.

JUH was started in 1936 and established in 1941 as a pioneer educational centre to impart education in Urdu medium to the deprived classes of India. It successfully conduct its examinations of Adeeb (High School), Mahir (Intermediate), Kamil (Graduation), Fazil (PG), Moallim (Teacher's Training) and Takhassus (D.Litt) on oriental pattern every year with nearly 113 Centres spread over the country. Their courses have been already recognized by the Central Government, several State Governments, Commissions, Boards and Universities of India having several favourable Supreme Court and High Court Judgments.
